We invite submissions of articles focusing on the following topics:

- Business and Human Rights;
- Corporate responsibility for violations of international humanitarian law;
- Legal and voluntary regulation specifically within the food- or the clothing sector (deadline: 15 January 2020).

Articles not relating to the special focus of this issue are equally welcome. Contributions can be submitted in English or German. We further welcome conference reports, book reviews (upon request), and case notes. All articles are subject to a double blind peer-review process by the editorial and advisory board.
